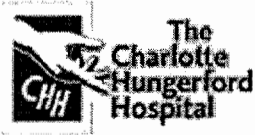

To Whom It May Concern:

The Charlotte Hungerford Hospital (the "Hospital") holds the above-referenced Nuclear Regulatory Commission license. On behalf of the Hospital, I am writing to provide a courtesy notice that the Hospital will experience a change in its corporate member (the "Organizational Change") effective January 1, 2018 (the "Effective Date"). Specifically, Hartford Healthcare Corporation, a Connecticut non-stock corporation, will become the sole corporate member of the Hospital on the Effective Date.

The Organizational Change is a change in the corporate parent of the Hospital, it will not result in any assets or operations being transferred from the Hospital, and will have no impact on the Hospital's legal name, federal tax identification number, location, or direct supervising personnel. The Organizational Change will result in the addition of two directors of the Hospital on the parent board.

There will be not changes in personnel or duties that relate to the licensed program. There will be no changes in the location, facilities, equipment, radiation program use, possession, waste management, or other procedures that relate to the licensed program.

The status of the Charlotte Hungerford Hospital facilities, equipment, and radiation safety program will not change. Calibrations on the equipment are to date: 2007 Siemens Biograph 64 performed on June 7, 2017, 2002 GE Millennium MG performed on June 1, 2017, and the 2002 GE Millennium MC performed on June 1, 2017. All leak tests, area surveys, wipe tests, quality control records, and other related records are in order and meet the NRC guidelines, as reviewed in our last Nuclear Regulatory Commission inspection on January 17, 2018, with Farrah Gaskins.



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There will be neither changes to the decommissioning funding plans nor any changes to the financial assurance documents as a result of the change of corporate member.

There will be no changes in the control of the licensed material and activity.

As in the past, Charlotte Hungerford Hospital will continue to abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments set by the NRC program. The Hospital appreciates the opportunity to provide the Nuclear Regulatory Commission with this notice letter.
