By letter dated January 22, 2018, HHC Health Care, LLC submitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) a Request for Consent to direct License Transfer of NRC Materials License No. 24-35232-01. By letter dated February 14, 2018, Heart Care Specialists, LLC provided additional information regarding the transfer of control. The letters are available electronically from the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) at Accession Nos. ML18025B125 and ML18046A043, respectively. Based on the information provided, we understand that as a result of acquisition of HHC Health Care, LLC, control will be directly transferred to Heart Care Specialists, LLC. We further understand that this transfer will not result in any change to the licensed materials, persons using the licensed material, locations of use of licensed material, or persons responsible for the licensee's radiation safety program.


Based on the above understandings and as more fully detailed in the enclosed NRC staff's Safety Evaluation Report which documents the NRC staff's review of the request, we have no objection to the proposed transfer. Please note that you will need to notify us promptly, in writing, after the transaction has been finalized and include a signed copy of the agreement confirming completion of the transaction. With this information, we can issue an administrative amendment to your NRC license to reflect the transaction. If this planned sale has not been consummated within 30 days of the date of this letter, please notify us in writing.
