**SUBJECT: RESPONSE TO NRC INSPECTION REPORT 030-14636/2017-001 AND NOTICE
OF VIOLATION**

Dear Lt. Col. Morgan:

On February 2, 2018, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) cited U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Fort Worth District Safety Office for three violations, which involved the failure to: 1) secure a portable nuclear gauge with two tangible barriers when not under control and constant surveillance; 2) test sealed sources for leakage and/or contamination at the required interval prior to use or transfer; and 3) implement and maintain the model procedures in Appendix H of NUREG-1556, Vol. 1, Rev. 1, as committed to during the license renewal. Inspection Report 030-14636/2017-001 with enclosed Notice of Violation (Notice) required you to respond in writing in 30 days (NRC Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession ML18029A256). In a letter dated March 7, 2018, you provided your response to the Notice of Violation (ML18079A108).

After reviewing the information provided in your response to the Notice, we have concluded that your completed and proposed actions appear to adequately address the regulatory noncompliance described in the Notice. We will review your implementation of these corrective actions during a future inspection to determine whether full compliance has been restored and whether compliance will be maintained.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.390 of the NRC's "Agency Rules of Practice and Procedures," a copy of this letter will be made available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room or from the NRC's ADAMS, accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html>.
