Many laws passed by Congress give Federal agencies some flexibility in deciding how best to implement those laws

Importantly, Executive Order 13563 asks agencies "to use the best available techniques to quantify anticipated present and future benefits and costs as accurately as possible." It also authorizes agencies to consider, and discuss qualitatively, "values that are difficult or impossible to quantify, including equity, human dignity, fairness, and distributive impacts."
