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General Comment

Comment for Draft Regulatory Guide DG1329, Proposed Revision 4 to Regulatory Guide RG 1.8,
Qualifications and
Training of Personnel for Nuclear Power Plants

The new Draft RG endorses ANS/ANSI-3.1.2014 whereas the current standard indorses the 1993 version.

- Many plants are still operating with commitments to pre-TMI Regulatory Guidelines, including this one.
- NRC review of the range of plants that still commit to the pre-TMI RGs are in-order.
- This draft also specifically addresses NRC inspection observations that have identified that plants have assigned

inadequately qualified RPMs and others temporary inadequately qualified RPMs for such lengths of time that it

appeared they were permanent appointees. This had to do with the position inadvertently deleted in Rev. 3 of this RG 1.8. Based on the industry relying on risked based decision making, it would be prudent to do a review

of the current nuclear power plant organizational structure since TMI to determine if any added positions are needed

(i.e., Outage Mangers, Work Control, and etc...).
