UPGRADING OF EMERGENCY SUPPORT FACILITIES  
NO. 1 AND 2 UNITS  
SALEM NUCLEAR GENERATING STATION  
DOCKET NOS. 50-272 AND 50-311

Our letter of August 8, 1980 addressed the implementation of the "Dated Requirements" contained in NUREG-0694, "TMI Related Requirements for New Operating Licenses" with respect to Salem 2 (Docket No. 50-311), including item III.A.1.2, concerning upgrading of emergency support facilities. This letter is intended to further clarify our understanding in this regard.

The onsite Technical Support Center (TSC) was described in our letters of January 2 1980 (Salem 1) and January 4, 1980 (Salem 2), along with conceptual plans for upgrading the TSC to meet the requirements of NUREG-0578 and your letters of September 13, September 27, October 30, and November 9, 1979.

The Emergency Operations Facility (EOF), located at our Quinton Training Facility, was described in our letter of July 3, 1980. This letter proposed that the EOF at this location be activated on an interim basis until such time as final NRC guidance has been issued, agreement on a permanent site has been reached, and the permanent EOF is ready for service.

Your letter concerning post-TMI requirements dated October 31, 1980 transmitted a document to be published as NUREG-0737 incorporating all TMI related items approved for implementation by the Commission, along with implementation schedules. Your letter further indicated that additional guidance on Emergency Response Facilities will be provided in the near future.
