Dear Ms. Carrasquillo:

This is in reference to the letter dated November 29, 2017 (received by NRC February 9, 2018) requesting to amend Nuclear Regulatory Commission License No. 06-31409-01. In order to continue our review, we need the following additional information:

1. To support that your request is a name change only from Northeast Regional Oncology Network, Inc. to NRRON, LLC, please answer the following:
  - a. NUREG-1556, Volume 15, Rev. 1 defines control of a license as “in the hands of the person or persons who are empowered to decide when and how that license will be used. That control is to be found in the person or persons who, because of ownership or authority explicitly delegated by the owners, possess the power to determine corporate policy and thus, the direction of the activities under the license.” Please confirm that the name change is not the result of a change of control as defined above.
2. Your current license lists licensee name as Northeast Radiation Oncology Network, Inc. d/b/a Community Cancer Care. Your request states to change the name to NRRON, LLC. Please confirm if the name should also include d/b/a Community Cancer Care.

We will continue our review upon receipt of the requested information.
