Dear Ms. Monday:

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), is returning without further action, application XW008/05 (enclosed) submitted on March 24, 2017. The application requested license amendments to: 1) change the licensee's point of contact; 2) change the foreign suppliers name from Atomic Energy of Canada Limited to Canadian Nuclear Laboratories; 3) remove reference to Waste Classification as defined in CFR 61.55 and reference to Table A2 values of 49 CFR 173.435 from the waste description; and 4) remove previous references to Import License IW012/05; 5) change the date of expiration to March 31, 2022; 6) include two ports of exit in New York and Michigan; and 7) allow for the export of Class A, B, and/or C radioactive waste.

The reason for the return is that Perma-Fix Environmental Service, Inc., on behalf of Diversified Scientific Services, Inc., submitted a revised application on February 9, 2018, which will replace the March 24, 2017, application XW008/05. Accordingly, the NRC will review February 9, 2018, application in accordance with applicable regulations in 10 CFR Part 110.41, "Executive Branch Review".
