Hi Jean,

We have reviewed and discussed the NRC draft Amendment to the Ross PA. An Amendment to alter the role of the BLM probably should have been completed some time ago. We recommend that you split this draft amendment into two amendments. The first amendment would be simple and would clarify the role of BLM in the project and alter statements in the PA concerning actions that no longer involve BLM. BLM could sign such an amendment.

The draft you have prepared adds a number of additional statements and a table of site eligibilities as an amendment to the PA. BLM is on record as disagreeing with the NRC on many of these statements. It would not be reasonable to expect the BLM to sign an amendment that contains such items. Following the first Amendment that removes the role of the BLM, you can put the remainder of the draft amendment into a second amendment.

It looks like the draft contains most or all of the language you will need for the two amendments and it would take little time to separate them out.

Good afternoon,

Attached is a draft version of the Ross PA Amendment. This draft amendment includes modifications resulting from our June 17, 2016 meeting, including a simplified accounting of Strata's withdrawal of the POO, an accounting of completed PA Stipulations or portions of, an updated table of historic properties identified and adds language to capture the anticipated changes if Wyoming becomes an NRC Agreement State. It also clarifies how the PA can be closed out to successful implementation of the PA Stipulations. Although we started drafting the current amendment with the 2016 version previously reviewed, the attached amendment is significantly different. Because of this and the length of time since we last discussed the amendment, I have attached a clean version of the draft amendment. I believe this is a more useful starting point for our current review and discussion.

Please provide your thoughts and comments on the draft amendment either via letter or via email within 30 days of receiving this email. Rather than hold a separate conference call to discuss the amendment, I plan to hold a webinar during/immediately following Strata's 2017 Annual Report call to take place winter/spring of 2018. During the webinar, we can determine if further calls are needed. All comments provided before the webinar will be incorporated in the draft I use on the webinar to facilitate our discussion/revision of the draft amendment. Comments and suggestions provided during the webinar can be incorporated as they are identified. If you would like to discuss the draft with me prior to the webinar, I welcome your calls. I will gladly send paper copies if you send me an email request.

Once the amendment is agreed upon, I will send the final version out for signature. If you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to contact me via phone or email.

Thank you for your continued support and input to the PA Implementation process.
