NRC Reactor Oversight Process (ROP)

- Process is implemented in each of the four NRC regions
- Process involves inspection and assessment activities controlled by each NRC region's senior management
- Process is implemented by regional inspectors and onsite resident NRC inspectors



- NRC resident inspectors live in the local communities and perform inspection activities at McGuire Nuclear Station
- Provide daily oversight of plant activity





- Daily visits to the control room
- Periodic meetings with plant senior managers
- Prioritize inspections based on important plant activity



• Observe emergency drills and provide support to NRC decision makers for any real emergencies or urgent is sues







- Process concerns raised by plant employees and the public
- Routinely discuss safety concerns with plant personnel and senior management



NRC Annual Assessment Summary MCGUIRE NUCLEAR STATION

- Duke Energy operated the plant safely and in a manner that preserved the public health and safety and protected the environment
- All inspection findings identified were of very low safety significance -GREEN



McGuire Nuclear Station Findings and Performance Indicators

- 3 Green non-cited violations identified in 2017
- All Performance Indicators were Green (no performance thresholds exceeded)



NRC Annual Assessment Summary MCGUIRE NUCLEAR STATION

- McGuire Nuclear Station remained in the Licensee Response Column of the NRC's ROP Action Matrix for the last quarter of 2017
- NRC plans routine baseline inspections at the McGuire Nuclear Station for 2018
