The response should also confirm that this interface program includes periodic communication between licensee/applicant and the vendor and a system of positive feedback which confirms receipt by the licensee/applicant of transmittals of technical information. The licensee has responded and our review finds the licensee's responses to Generic Letter 83-28 Item 2.1 (Part 2) to be acceptable. The enclosed SER documents our findings.
