Dear Mr. Huebner:

This refers to your license amendment request dated December 19, 2017. Please find enclosed Amendment No. 39 authorizing Trent W. Shelton, D.O. as an authorized user for 10 CFR 35.100 and 10 CFR 35.200, and Jed A. Hummel, M.D. for 10 CFR 35.100, 10 CFR 35.200, and the oral administration of sodium iodide iodine 131 less than 33 millicuries. Please note that we could not grant authorization for Dr. Hummel for 10 CFR 35.300 oral administration of sodium iodide iodine 131 in quantities greater than 33 millicuries because your license does not currently authorize that use. We could not authorize Alan Coleman, M.D. as an authorized user for 10 CFR 35.100 and 35.200, and Trent W. Shelton, D.O. for materials authorized by 10 CFR 35.300 at this time as additional documentation is required. In addition, we could not authorize your request to change Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) as we needed additional information for both of your proposed candidates. Based on my discussions with Shari Patch of your organization, we understand that James Rademacher, M.D. will remain the RSO until you can supply the additional documentation for another individual, and that there would be delay in supplying the additional information needed for Dr. Shelton and Dr. Coleman. You may submit a new amendment request as the information becomes available. The following additional information is needed in order to authorize Dr. Shelton and Dr. Coleman:


1. Please confirm the specific authorizations being requested for Dr. Shelton. In addition, please submit clinical casework for Dr. Shelton which demonstrates experience for the uses which he is seeking authorization. You can resubmit form 313A (AUT) and include this information in Section 3.c.
2. Please submit training and experience for Dr. Coleman. You may submit NRC form 313A (AUD).

In addition, in order to add Daniel R. Mitchell, M.D. as the Radiation Safety Officer, please submit a description of the training and experience specified in 10 CFR 35.50(e) demonstrating that Dr. Mitchell is qualified by training in radiation safety, regulatory issues, and emergency procedures applicable to the types of use on your license and written attestation, signed by a preceptor RSO, that the individual satisfactorily completed the requirements in 35.50(c)(2). Please note that the training should be within the last seven years.

An environmental assessment for this action was not required, since this action is categorically excluded under 10 CFR 51.22(c)(14).
