MPI Research, Inc. and Charles River Laboratories International, Inc. (collectively, the “Parties”) previously submitted indirect change in control notifications and approval requests (the “Requests”) to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) with respect to the above-referenced Licenses (M/C 602604 and 602605). Those Requests were submitted consistent with NUREG-1556, Volume 15, Revision 1, “Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses, Guidance About Changes of Control and About Bankruptcy Involving Byproduct, Source, or Special Nuclear Material Licenses” and NRC Regulatory Issue Summary 2014-08, Revision 1, “Regulatory Requirements for Transfer of Control (Change of Ownership) of Specific Material Licenses.”

As we committed to do with respect to these Requests, we hereby advise the NRC that, on April 3, 2018, the Parties completed the transaction that was the subject of the Requests.

As a result, as of April 3, 2018, MPI Research, Inc. became and is now an indirect wholly owned subsidiary of Charles River Laboratories International, Inc., consistent with the organization chart provided with the Requests. The transaction resulted in no change to MPI Research, Inc.’s name, to the licensed materials (the “Licensed Materials”), to the location of the Licensed Materials, to the financial assurance mechanism in place with respect to the Licensed Materials, or to the person(s) responsible for the Licensed Materials and the radiation safety program.


The undersigned, acting on behalf of the Parties, have full knowledge of the matters addressed herein.
