CONFIRMATION OF INDIRECT TRANSFER OF CONTROL

This Confirmation of Indirect Transfer of Control (this "Confirmation") is hereby affirmed, effective February 20, 2018 (the "Effective Date"), by and between Stonewall Jackson Memorial Hospital Company, a West Virginia non-profit corporation ("Stonewall") and Monongalia Health System, Inc., a West Virginia non-profit corporation ("MHS"). Stonewall and MHS are individually referred to herein as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties".

WHEREAS, the Parties entered into a Definitive Agreement made as of July 10, 2017 (the "Definitive Agreement") whereby the Parties agreed that MHS would become the sole member of Stonewall (the "Affiliation");

WHEREAS, the Affiliation was consummated on October 1, 2017, at which time MHS became the sole member of Stonewall, although Stonewall remains a separate legal entity, the licensee, owner and operator of the hospital located in Weston, West Virginia, and the holder of that certain Materials License from the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the "NRC"), numbered 47-18080-01 and expiring September 30, 2024 (the "NRC License");

WHEREAS, under the Definitive Agreement, the Parties agreed that MHS would not in any way transfer, assign or in any manner dispose of, either voluntarily or involuntarily, directly or indirectly, through transfer of control of the NRC License to any person or by acting to control the direction of activities under, or activities related to compliance with, the requirements of the NRC License until such time as NRC consent to the indirect transfer of control of the NRC License was granted; and

WHEREAS, on January 31, 2017, the NRC issued that certain Safety Evaluation Report, Docket No. 030-14445, License No. 47-18080-01 (the "SER"), consenting to the indirect transfer of control of the NRC License.

NOW, THEREFORE, consistent with the terms and conditions of that certain Definitive Agreement, the SER and this Confirmation, the Parties affirm as follows.


1. On October 1, 2017, MHS became the sole member of Stonewall. On January 31, 2018, the NRC issued the SER, consenting to the indirect transfer of control of the NRC License. With the issuance of the SER and the further submission of this Confirmation to the NRC, the requirements under the Definitive Agreement in respect to the indirect transfer of control of the NRC License have been satisfied, and the indirect transfer of control is effective as of the Effective Date.

2. Notwithstanding the above, the Affiliation and subsequent consent by the NRC to an indirect transfer of control of the NRC License has not resulted in any change in the licensee name, licensed materials, persons using the licensed materials, location of use, or persons responsible for the radiation safety program at Stonewall or otherwise.


3. The terms of the Affiliation, as set forth in the Definitive Agreement, are consistent with the information and findings documented in the SER, including the Parties' commitments set forth in the "Safety and Security Review" section of the SER.

This Confirmation is hereby affirmed as of the Effective Date.
