Mr. Schlitt:

I have been assigned to review your change of address application dated April 2, 2018.

This should be a simple amendment, but I need to make sure that nothing has changed with regard to control of the licensed activity.

As stated in NUREG-1556, "Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses," Volume 15, "Guidance About Changes of Control and About Bankruptcy Involving Byproduct, Source, or Special Nuclear Materials Licenses" (<https://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/nuregs/staff/sr1556/v15/>), 10 CFR 30.34(b) requires, in part, that "No license issued or granted pursuant to the regulations, nor any right under a license shall be transferred, assigned or in any manner disposed of, either voluntarily or involuntarily, directly or indirectly, through transfer of control of any license to any person, unless the Commission shall, after securing full information, find that the transfer is in accordance with the provisions of the Act and shall give its consent in writing." Therefore, control of licenses cannot be transferred without the prior written consent of the Commission. This requires that licensees notify the Commission that they are undergoing a possible change of control. The details are in Chapter 5 and Appendices B through E.

Please review this guidance and let me know at your earliest convenience whether your change of address is in any way associated with a change of control.
