Am I correct in assuming that this email is the letter (or includes the full content of the letter)? If not, would you please provide a copy of the actual letter?

Specifically I am looking for the estimated time for NRC to complete the technical review of the surety and related licensing action. In a meeting with Bill Von Till and Andrea Koch in December 2016, Bill told us that current Uranium Recovery Branch practice was that all submittals to NRC would be acknowledged with an acceptance and that the acceptance would include an estimated schedule for completion of action on the submittal.
