By letter dated December 8, 1993, Public Service Electric and Gas Company (PSE&G) submitted license change request, LCR 91-06, Rev. 2, to the NRC. The submittal proposes to revise:

- (1) Existing Technical Specification 3/4.4.3 and 3/4.4.5 for Units 1 & 2 respectively, referring to the Power Operated Relief Valves associated with each Pressurizer
- (2) Existing Technical Specification 3.4.9.3 and 3.4.10.3 for Units 1 & 2 respectively, referring to the Overpressure Protection System associated with the each Pressurizer
- (3) Existing Technical Specification 3.5.3 and 3.5.3 for Units 1 & 2 respectively, associated with each reactor's Emergency Core Cooling System.

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and Energy's Bureau of Nuclear Engineering (BNE) has reviewed the request in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 50.91(b) and has no comments.

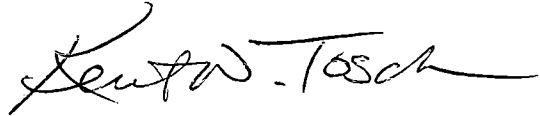
