The subject request was submitted to the NRC by Public Service Electric and Gas on September 20, 1994. The request proposes to reduce the secondary side steam pressure required for surveillance testing of the steam turbine driven Auxiliary Feedwater Pump for Salem Units 1 and 2. The proposed change also clarifies the time required to perform the steam turbine driven Auxiliary Feedwater Pump surveillance test when entering Mode 3.
