Facility Operating Licenses DPR-70 and DPR-75  
Revision of Surveillance Requirements for Areas Within  
Containment -- LCR 94-33

On December 23, 1994, Public Service Electric and Gas Company (PSE&G) submitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) an application for an amendment to Appendix A of each of the aforementioned facilities operating licenses.

Via LCR 94-33, the licensee proposes to revise surveillance Technical Specification TS 4.5.2.c.2. The change request was initiated to implement a recommended line-item TS improvement per Generic Letter 93-05. The proposed change revises the current surveillance requirement by proposing to perform visual inspections of the containment areas, affected by containment entry, at least once every 24-hour period "... and during the final entry when CONTAINMENT INTEGRITY is established".

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection's Bureau of Nuclear Engineering has reviewed the request in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 50.91(b) and has no comments.


