**RETRACTION OF AUXILIARY BUILDING VENTILATION PORTION OF REQUEST
FOR CHANGE TO HVAC SYSTEM TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS
SALEM GENERATING STATION NO. UNIT 2
FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE DPR-75
DOCKET NO. 50-311**

Gentlemen:

In accordance with 10CFR50.90, on May 1, 1997, Public Service Electric & Gas (PSE&G) Company submitted letter LR-N97231, requesting a revision to the Technical Specifications (TS, LCR S97-06) for the Salem Generating Station Unit No 2.

The proposed TS changes represented the addition of a new Specification 3/4.7.11, "Switchgear and Penetration Area Ventilation System." This change was submitted to address the support function this system provides to other necessary safety systems. In addition, a change was proposed to TS Section 3.7.7.c. Specifically, a change from seven to 14 days was proposed for the allowed time for restoring at least two operable Auxiliary Building exhaust fans to operable status.

PSE&G is currently developing a comprehensive change request to Section 3/4.7.7, "Auxiliary Building Exhaust Filtration System". To simplify the administration of this new request, PSE&G hereby formally requests that the portion of the earlier TS change request LCR 97-06 which discussed the Auxiliary Building Ventilation (ABV) exhaust fan allowed out of service time be retracted.

The remainder of LCR S97-06 (i.e., Switchgear Penetration Area Ventilation System) is not intended to be impacted by either the TS change request being developed for the ABV or this request to retract the ABV section of LCR S97-06. Additional information regarding the SPAV portion of the TS S97-06 is being developed, and will be submitted under separate transmittal shortly.
