Random Testing Rate

Random Testing is conducted at an annualized rate of 50%. The rate of annual testing during this reporting period was 27.6% (1,092 random tests conducted with 3,962 workers eligible for testing).

Summary of Management Actions

Suspensions based on presumptive positives: 0

Reportable events: 2

During the time period January 1, 1997 to June 30, 1997, there were two reportable events.

- On 2/28/97, a contractor supervisor was reporting for work on the night shift. At the Security Center, the odor of alcohol on the individual prompted a "For Cause" evaluation. The BAC was .04%, and the MRO made a determination of unfitness. Plant access was denied, and PSE&G reported an incident involving alcohol use by a contractor supervisor.
- On 3/11/97, a contractor supervisor was called for random testing. The BAC was .04%, and the MRO made a determination of unfitness. Plant access was denied, and PSE&G reported an incident involving alcohol use by a contractor supervisor.

<u>Appeals/Resolutions:</u> During the time period January 1, 1997 to June 30, 1997, three appeals were resolved. One appeal resulted in reversal of original action.

- One fitness for duty appeal involved a claim that over the counter medications caused or contributed to a
 positive drug test result.
- One fitness for duty appeal resulted from an access denial due to falsification of security background information.
- One appeal resulted from a determination of "failure to cooperate" wherein an individual refused to complete the "For Cause" evaluation process.

Trends 1990 to Present

- Opiates: No MRO positives since the Fitness For Duty Rule went into effect.
- PCP: No positives during the last five years.
- Rare challenges to the accuracy and validity of Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) laboratory tests results.
- During the last three reporting periods, due to high level management concern, almost all individuals involved in work related accidents or incidents have been referred to the Medical Department for "For Cause" testing. "For Cause" testing for the six month period January 1, 1997 to June 30, 1997, yielded a positive rate of 8.2%. In addition, one third (4 out of 12) of the positive test results obtained during this time period were attributed to "For Cause" testing.

• During this six month period, 50% of positive test results were attributed to misuse of alcohol.

Recommendations:.

- Eliminate the second breath alcohol test when the first test is negative.
- After greater than 100,000 breath tests, equipment sensitivity of 100% has been demonstrated (second breath test has never been positive after the first breath test was negative). Cost savings over months to years would be considerable.
- Continue to permit/encourage on-site pre-screening.
- Continue to move toward "interchangeability" and mutual acceptance among related Fitness For Duty Programs (NRC, DOT, RSPA).
- Encourage the formation of Fitness For Duty Oversight Committees with participation from management and supervision, to promote understanding, mutual agreement, and resolution of Fitness For Duty issues.
