**REVISION TO COMMITMENT IN
RESPONSE TO NOTICE OF VIOLATION 50-272/97-12 AND 50-311/97-12
SALEM GENERATING STATION
UNIT NOS. 1 AND 2
DOCKET NOS. 50-272 AND 50-311**

Dear Ladies and Gentlemen:

By letter LR-N970440, dated July 30, 1997, in response to Notice of Violation 50-272/97-12 and 50-311/97-12, Public Service Electric and Gas (PSE&G) committed to the following action:

"Procedure SC.OP-AP.ZZ-0111, "Component Status Control" will be reviewed for enhancements to address updating TRIS upon return of component status from off-normal to normal. Review, revision, and training on the procedure will be completed by September 30, 1997."

According to the PSE&G commitment management program, PSE&G is revising its commitment to implement the revision and training on the procedure changes from September 30, 1997 to November 14, 1997.

During the review of procedure SC.OP-AP.ZZ-0111, "Component Status Control" to determine if enhancements were necessary, Operations Management determined that procedure SC.OP-AP.ZZ-0111 should be combined with procedure SC.OP-AP.ZZ-0103, "TRIS Configuration Control" to create a new procedure. This new procedure, SC.OP-AP.ZZ-0103 "Component Configuration Control," effectively eliminates conflicting guidance that existed between the original procedures. In order to allow sufficient time to develop effective training material on the new procedure and to conduct the appropriate training of the Operations Department staff and operating crews, additional time is required to properly implement the newly enhanced and combined procedures.

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
