First, my apologies to Richard Brown for leaving a message on voice mail. You were the license contact and RSO in 2014 when the license was last renewed. I was looking at the renewal, comparing it to this 2018 amendment request, and inadvertently called you first.

However, you are the current RSO, it is still appropriate to include you on this email.

Comparing the 2014 application to the 2018 amendment, you state in Item 3 that licensed material will be stored and dispatched from an address in North Carolina. It is not clear to me if you are requesting this as a change on your NRC license. If so, please note that the NRC does not have jurisdiction in North Carolina; you will need a specific license from North Carolina [if you don't already have one] in order to store material there. This will not change anything on the NRC license.

Otherwise, the only change appears to be the RSO change. Please confirm if this is correct.
