Dear Mr. Avicasis:

This letter is in response to your application, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) Form 313, dated March 14, 2018, and letter dated February 20, 2018, requesting an amendment to add two models to your Exempt Distribution License Number 04-23946-01E.

We do not have sufficient information to complete the review of your application. In the enclosure to this letter you will find the list of the questions and items not addressed in your application.

Please be aware that upon your request, proprietary information submitted to the NRC may be withheld from public disclosure. To do this, you must follow the procedures in Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) 2.390(b) including requesting withholding at the time the information is submitted and complying with the document marking and affidavit requirements set forth in 10 CFR 2.390(b)(1).

We will continue our review upon receipt of this information. If we do not receive your reply within 30 calendar days from the date of this letter, we will consider your application as having been abandoned by you. This action would be without prejudice to the resubmission of another application with the required information.

Your application for a distribution license should not contain information concerning the possession and use of radioactive material because that is covered in a separate possession license.

REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff has reviewed the Multi Time Machine, Inc., application dated March 14, 2018, and letter dated February 20, 2018, and has determined that additional information is needed. In order to continue with our review, please address the issues listed below.

The information related to review of your exempt distribution license application is required by Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations*, Chapter 32 (10 CFR 32), Sections 32.14 and 32.15, and is described in the relevant guidance document NUREG-1556, Volume 8, titled "Program-Specific Guidance about Exempt Distribution Licenses," available on the NRC public we site (<https://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/doc-collections/nuregs/staff/sr1556/v8/>).

As noted in the accompanying letter, upon your request, proprietary information submitted to the NRC may be withheld from public disclosure. To do this, you must follow the procedures in 10 CFR 2.390(b) including requesting withholding at the time the information is submitted and complying with the document marking and affidavit requirements set forth in 10 CFR 2.390(b)(1).

Please provide the information required by each of the following regulations. You may need to obtain some of this information from your supplier(s). Note that it is the applicant's responsibility to confirm the validity of all information.

1. Please resubmit the last two pages of the letter (Page Title: Rad Case Design and Page Title: Predator Case Design) because the bottom halves of these pages are virtually illegible.
2. Items 1.A and 1.B in your application provide Sealed Source and Device Registration numbers that supersede previous registration numbers. Please indicate whether any product models currently listed on your license are affected by these changes, and if so, identify which models and how they are affected.
3. 10 CFR 32.14(b)(2) requires the applicant to submit details of construction and design of each product. Please provide this information. You may submit information provided from your previous submittal(s) if the details of construction and design are the same as those for product models currently listed on your license; however, you should indicate how this information applies to the new models.
4. 10 CFR 32.14(b)(3) requires the applicant to submit the method of containment or binding of the byproduct material in the product. You may submit information provided from your previous submittal(s) if details of the method of containment or binding of the byproduct material are the same as those for product models currently listed on your license; however, you should indicate how this information applies to the new models.

Please provide copies, drawings, or photographs of your proposed method of labeling the containers of these products.

6. 10 CFR 32.15(b)(1) states that no person licensed under Section 32.14 shall transfer to other persons for use under Section 30.15 of this chapter or equivalent regulations of an Agreement State any part or product tested and found defective under the criteria and procedures specified in the license issued under Section 32.14, unless the defective part or product has been repaired or reworked, retested, and found by an independent inspector to meet the applicable acceptance criteria. Please describe how you will prevent the transfer to other persons for use under Section 30.15 of this chapter or equivalent regulations of an Agreement State any part or product tested and found defective under the criteria and procedures specified in the license issued under Section 32.14.
