The subject request was submitted to the NRC by PSE&G letter dated October 12, 1998. This request proposes a one-time modification to Technical Specification Surveillance Requirements 4.3.2.1.3 (Instrumentation, ESF Actuation System Instrumentation); 4.8.2.3.2.f (Electrical Power Systems, 125volt DC Distribution); 4.8.2.5.2.c.2 and 4.8.2.5.2.d (Electrical Power Systems, 28volt DC Distribution). These surveillance tests will be completed prior to entering Mode 4 following the upcoming refueling outage, which is scheduled to commence in April of 1999.
