You have listed Mr. Richard Goodnight to be the Radiation Safety Officer, however, no evidence of training and experience was provided to support Mr. Goodnight's qualification. Please provide Mr. Goodnight's training and experience that demonstrates he is qualified to be the Radiation Safety Officer. The guidance for training is in section 8.7.1 of [NUREG-1556, Volume 4, Rev. 1, "Consolidated Guidance About Materials Licenses Program-Specific Guidance About Fixed Gauge Licenses"](#) If you propose a different Radiation Safety Officer, please provide their training and experience.
