2	Organization of Agreement States (OAS)	Page 1-1, Lines 14-23	The passage in this text is supposed to be taken from 10 CFR 150.11(a); however, the equation should be listed after Line 23 with the following inserted before it: For example, the following quantities in combination would not exceed the limitation and are within the formula, as follows: [insert equation]. The actual formula would have variables in the numerators for the specific quantity that a licensee may possess. Adding the formula may help clarify this passage.	Comment accepted. The equation was moved to after Line 23 and the following was inserted before the equation: For example, the following quantities in combination would not exceed the limitation and are within the formula, as follows:
3	OAS	Page I-6, Lines 34-35	A good air sampling program cannot always prevent the need for a bioassay program. The air sample results could indicate the need to require bioassay samples.	Comment accepted. The word "can" was changed to "may" in the following sentence, "The use of engineering controls and a good air sampling program can may eliminate the need for bioassays.
4	OAS	Page I-9, Lines 9-15	Elevated air monitoring results should be included in the bulleted list as a reason to do special bioassay measurements.	Comment accepted. The following bullet was added in the "Special Monitoring" portion of Appendix I regarding whether potential intakes should be evaluated: elevated air monitoring results
