Dear Ms. Hirst:

On March 20, 2018, members of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff met with you at 232 N. Elm Street, Waterbury, Connecticut and delivered a letter, dated March 7, 2018, entitled "Remediation and Forgoing of Licensing of Waterbury Clock Company – 7." The NRC letter is available in the NRC Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) at accession number ML17318A176.

The NRC staff discussed the terms and conditions contained in the letter. Provided those terms and conditions are met, the NRC will not require you to obtain a license. At the conclusion of our visit, NRC staff observed the affected areas of 232 N. Elm Street, Waterbury, Connecticut and confirmed that the controls you previously committed to (restricting or limiting access) remain in place.

In accordance with the terms and conditions of the March 7, 2018, letter, the next milestone will be your submission of a remediation schedule and funding plan to the NRC. We respectfully request an estimate regarding when the schedule and plan will be submitted to the NRC. We request that this estimate be provided in writing not later than June 30, 2018. We recognize your status as a non-profit organization and understand that actual available funding may affect any proposed schedule.
