
This letter confirms my May 4, 1979 telephone conversation with Mr. William T. Russell of NRC-NRR.

On May 4, my staff advised me that a computer deck had been identified, on May 3, as associated with the SHOCK 0 program.

This information supersedes that provided to you in our April 27 Status Report on our plan for verification of dynamic analysis codes.

Although review of this new information is not completed, we have determined that it does not combine inertial forces algebraically at the intramodal level.
