Please accept this letter as a request to amend mb microtec's SSD #NR-0446-D-103.

mb microtec is rebranding its GTLS's (gaseous tritium light sources) from mb microtec to trivalight®. While mb microtec ag will continue to be the manufacturer and manufacture the GTLS's in the same location in Neiderwangen, Switzerland, we would like to request an amendment to the aforementioned SSD, to remove "mb-microtec" from the watch backs and replace the text with "trivalight®".

trivalight® is an officially registered trademark of mb microtec in the US. Documentation of this trademark and other trademarks is included with this request.

Examples of watch backs with the new engraving are included with this request.

For clarification:

The dial face will continue to be marked with "T" (for tritium) as recommended in "Radiation Protection Standards for Gaseous Tritium Light Devices" Section 7 - Marking and Labeling (Nuclear energy Agency, OECD, 1973).

The bottom (watch back) will continue to be marked with "H3."

"traser®" is the brand of watch manufactured by mb microtec.

"trivalight®" is the brand of GTLS manufactured by mb microtec.

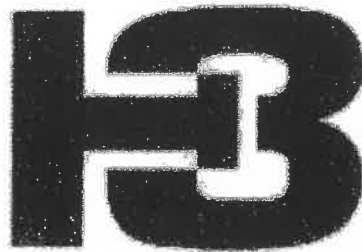

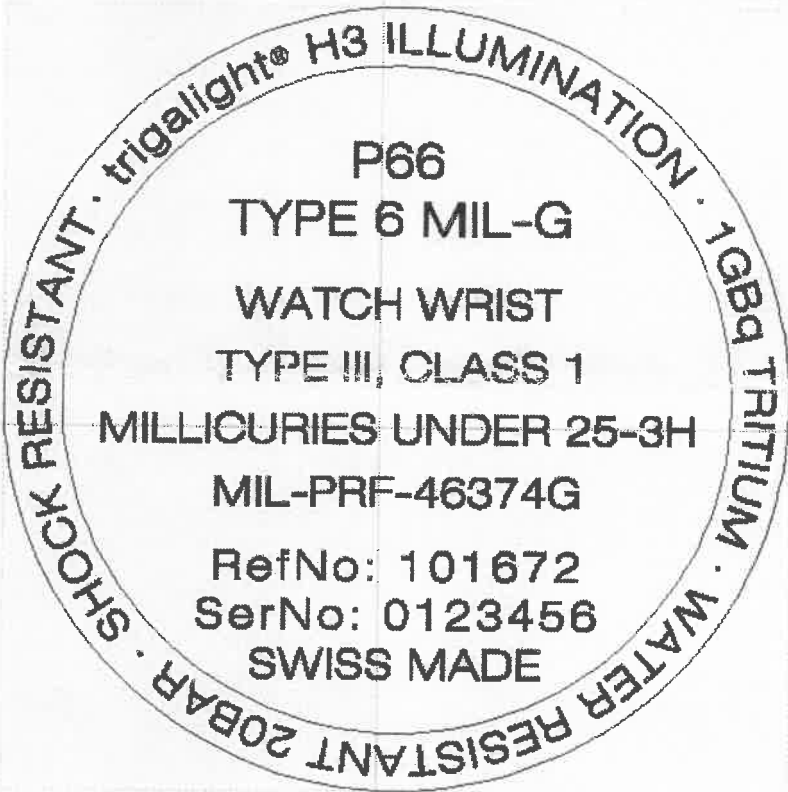
