- Employer of Choice to more than 230 people
- During construction, UUSA logged over 17 million work hours without a lost time incident
- Safety continues to be our number one priority
- No injuries onsite this year to date

- When construction began at UUSA, it was the first new nuclear project in almost 30 years
- UUSA is the only producer of enriched uranium in North America
- UUSA's 63 cascades in operation, produces 4.9 million SWU making it the 5th largest enrichment site in the world
- As the only enricher in the US, we provide energy security to the electricity industry
- 7% of the electricity generated in the US uses nuclear fuel which URENCO USA has processed

- Safety is the cornerstone of our operations
- Safety includes industrial, nuclear, radiological and security safety
- We maintain the attitude to “Be Our Family’s Keeper”
- Certified under ISO 9001

- UUSA has a comprehensive and rigorous program for Material Control and Accounting
- We cooperate with our government regarding support of non-proliferation
- The protection of Special Nuclear Material and classified information is a facet of safety and a top priority

Radiological Controls



- We implement comprehensive and rigorous programs for Radiation Protection, Environmental Protection, Waste Management and Transportation
- We have industry experts in these fields working at our facility
- Our programs are inspected by and must comply with both NRC and State of New Mexico regulations

- We have an extensive program for Emergency Preparedness with an Emergency Operations Center along with an Alternate Emergency Operations Center and Joint Information Center
- We routinely perform drills and emergency exercises with all of our mutual aid organizations in Lea and Andrews Counties

- UUSA routinely hosts a variety of community events such as:
 - Richie Science Workshops, Relay for Life, & The Robotics Expo
- 9/11 Day of Remembrance Project
 - Since 2008, UUSA has made repairs on 135 senior citizen's homes in Eunice, NM and Andrews, TX
- Post-construction UUSA donated furniture & appliances to:
 - Habitat for Humanity; City of Eunice; Salvation Army; Hearts Desire; Lea County Museum; Boy Scouts of America; Legacy Pregnancy Center; My Power; Embrace Grace; Faith in Action; Guidance Center of Lea County
