Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.82(a)(7), the United States Maritime Administration (MARAD) hereby requests withdrawal of the Nuclear Ship SAVANNAH (NSS) Post Shutdown Decommissioning Activities Report (PSDAR), Revision 0 which was submitted as Reference (a).

As a direct result of funding shortfalls associated with Continuing Appropriations Resolutions for FY 2007, MARAD has concluded the decommissioning schedule in Revision 0 is no longer achievable. Therefore, MARAD must withdraw Revision 0 pending its reassessment of decommissioning activities. MARAD will revise the PSDAR as appropriate and submit Revision 1 at a future date.
