Enclosed is Amendment No. 01 terminating your NRC Materials License No. 21-32817-01MD in accordance with your request dated January 26, 2018.

In letter dated January 26, 2018, you informed the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission that you wished to terminate NRC Materials License No. 21-32817-01MD for Lakeview Diagnostic. The aforementioned letter included NRC Form 314, "Certificate of Disposition of Materials," (with attachments), supporting the decommissioning of your location at 36211 Jefferson Avenue, Harrison Township, Michigan.


The NRC staff has reviewed all of this information, including your final status surveys. Based on its review, the staff has concluded that all licensable radioactive material has been removed from your facility and residual radioactive material attributable to licensed activities does not exceed current NRC criteria.

Based on these conclusions, no further remediation or actions with respect to NRC regulated material is required. Your facility at 36211 Jefferson Avenue, Harrison Township, Michigan, is suitable for unrestricted use and NRC License No. 21-32817-01MD is hereby terminated.
