1. All items in your application and attached document reference NUREG 1556 Vol. 4 dated October 1998. This guidance document has since been revised; please now use NUREG 1556 Vol. 4 Rev. 1 dated July 2016. You may find this document at the link below, and an updated application has also been attached for your convenience.

Please take note of "AND" and "OR" statements when completing the application. Additionally, please note that Item 10.8 has two sections that both need a response.

2. In your submitted application you request to perform non-routine maintenance activities. Please use the attached NUREG 1556 Vol. 4 Rev. 1 Appendix J and submit all relevant information with your application. Please ensure that your response to Item 10.8 is consistent with your request to perform non-routine maintenance.

3. Please submit a new Delegation of Authority letter formally reappointing you to the role of Radiation Safety Officer. The letter must be signed by someone in your senior management chain. A sample letter is attached that you may modify as needed to meet your company's specific needs. Please ensure that individual's names and titles are printed below their signature.

4. Due to changes to our licensing process Items 6-9 on your license will now appear differently going forward. Specifically, instead of allowing a blanket amount of material to be split between multiple types of devices, each device manufacturer and model will now have their own limit. For Items 5-6 of your application please list out the following information:

- a. Isotope Requested
- b. Device Manufacturer
- c. Device Model
- d. Number of devices requested.
- e. Maximum activity for any single source.
- f. Total activity requested for devices of this manufacturer and model.
- g. For any of these devices if a specific sealed source is used please include the manufacturer and model number.

5. Your license currently authorized Depleted Uranium (DU) but this material was not listed in your submitted application. Please include with your response the total amount of DU requested in kilograms. If DU should no longer be listed in on the license please provide records confirming that all material has been disposed of or transferred to another licensed organization. This is currently on your license under Item 6-9 I.

6. Your current license under Condition 10.B. permits material to be used and stored at your Gary, IN. facility. The application submitted does not include this location of use. If this is still an active facility please include that in your response. If this facility should be removed from the license please provide records showing that all of the licensed material stored there has been removed. Please provide disposal or transfer records for any devices that were previously stored at this location along with a copy of the most recent leak test for each device.

7. Chris Sarvanidis and Anthony LaMastra are both included several times in your application but there is no mention of Kevin Lackman who is also listed on your license. Please clarify if Mr. Lackman should or should not be listed in Condition 17.A.

8. In your application you included an attachment titled "Policies Governing the Use of Ionizing Radiation," which includes a number of procedures and commitments to how you will run your radiation safety program. Please note that Condition 24 of your license requires that you follow any commitments that you make to the NRC that are more restrictive than the regulations. For example, this means that if this section of your application were to be included under Condition 24 that you would have to request a license amendment before you could change your procedures as that is what you would be legally committed to. As the information in the section is either redundant information from other sections of your application, or not required you may request to withdraw this section from your application if desired.
