Ladies and Gentlemen:


Pursuant to 10 CFR 52.99(c)(3), Southern Nuclear Operating Company hereby notifies the NRC that as of April 24, 2018, Vogtle Electric Generating Plant (VEGP) Unit 3 and Unit 4 Uncompleted Inspections, Tests, Analyses, and Acceptance Criteria (ITAAC) Item 2.7.02.01 [Index Number 701] has not been completed greater than 225-days prior to initial fuel load. The Enclosure describes the plan for completing this ITAAC. Southern Nuclear Operating Company will, at a later date, provide additional notifications for ITAAC that have not been completed 225-days prior to initial fuel load.

This notification is informed by the guidance described in NEI 08-01, *Industry Guideline for the ITAAC Closure Process Under 10 CFR Part 52*, which was endorsed by the NRC in Regulatory Guide 1.215. In accordance with NEI 08-01, this notification includes ITAAC for which required inspections, tests, or analyses have not been performed or have been only partially completed. All ITAAC will be fully completed and all Section 52.99(c)(1) ITAAC Closure Notifications will be submitted to NRC to support the Commission finding that all acceptance criteria are met prior to plant operation, as required by 10 CFR 52.103(g).

## **ITAAC Statement**

### **Design Commitment**

1. The functional arrangement of the VWS is as described in the Design Description of this Section 2.7.2.

### **Inspections/Tests/Analyses**

Inspection of the as-built system will be performed.

### **Acceptance Criteria**

The as-built VWS conforms with the functional arrangement as described in the Design Description of this Section 2.7.2.

## **ITAAC Completion Description**

An inspection of the as-built Central Chilled Water System (VWS) is conducted after completion of construction to confirm that the functional arrangement of the VWS is as described in the Design Description of Combined License (COL) Appendix C Section 2.7.2. This inspection encompasses the structures, systems, and components (SSCs) identified in the COL Appendix C Section 2.7.2, Design Description, including Figure 2.7.2-1 and Table 2.7.2-3.

The inspection (walkdown) is completed in accordance with ND-RA-001-012, Functional Arrangement Scoping Process (Reference 1), which requires the preparation of a detailed inspection plan. This inspection plan includes the use of detailed drawings such as Piping and Instrumentation Drawings (P&IDs) or Single Line Elementary Drawings to perform visual observations and compare the as-built system to the Design Description.

The inspection results are documented in the Unit 3 and Unit 4 Principal Closure Documents XXX and YYY (References 2 and 3, respectively) supporting the Unit 3 and Unit 4 ITAAC 2.7.02.01 Completion Packages (References 4 and 5, respectively) and verify that the SSCs are physically arranged and located to perform the functions described in the Design Description and referenced figure and table. The inspection results confirm that the as-built VWS conforms with the functional arrangement as described in the COL Appendix C Section 2.7.2, Design Description.

The Unit 3 and Unit 4 Principal Closure Documents XXX and YYY are available for NRC inspection as part of the ITAAC 2.7.02.01 Completion Packages.
