Chris,

Sorry the I didn't respond before but I do have a couple of comments in support of this public meeting.

1. I agree with several of the attendees in the discussion of cost and the time required to submit renewal and amendments. Renewals are fairly straightforward for us and require very little time to prepare. Amendments on the other hand can be very expensive especially for a very small company like SPEC. In fact we have withdrawn amendments in the past for that very reason.
2. NRC sometimes requires that a consolidated SAR be submitted after a certain amount of submissions, whether they be renewals and / or amendments. Consolidated submissions are extremely time consuming and costly. If the renewal period were to be reduced, then the timeframe for submitting consolidated SAR's would also be reduced, and that would impose an increased financial burden, especially on smaller companies.
