Hi Michelle,

Kathy Modes has requested we send you our license condition binding two Washington licensees to 10 CFR 36. Here is the condition:

“Requirements to Possess and Use the J.L. Shepherd and Associates Model 81-14 Beam Irradiator. The licensee must comply with 10 CFR Part 36, “Licenses and Radiation Safety Requirements For Irradiators”. Reference “Washington State Department of Health” whenever 10 CFR Part 36 uses the words “Commission”, “Nuclear Regulatory Commission”, or “NRC”. In 10 CFR 36.2, “Definitions”, paragraph 2 in the definition of “commencement of construction”, and paragraph 9(ii) in the definition of “construction” do not apply.”

In talking with our staff, we may have sent you this condition for review back in the 2014 timeframe. We are looking through our licensing files to see if we can find an approval letter from the NRC.

Please let us know if the NRC concurs with this license condition. Thanks,
