## Public Comment on *Review of Administrative Rules*

The U.S Nuclear Regulatory Commission is trying to identify some outdated or duplicative administrative requirements that may be eliminated without a negative effect on public health or safety, common defense and security, protection of the environment, or regulatory efficiency and effectiveness.

The most vital process during the review is to choose the evaluation criteria. The evaluation criteria should be developing by combining both the public opinions and the scientific analysis. The public opinions should consist of the discussed idea of the people who will be potentially influenced by the elimination of the administrative requirements. The scientific analysis should be depending on the statements of scientists who researched and analyzed deeply about the specific administrative rules.

Additionally, the initial idea of the rule, the administrative requirement should be understood completely and appropriately. This means that not only the general idea of the requirement should be researched but also the indirective potential reverse effects it's going to have should be deeply researched and analyzed. On the other hand, someone in charge of researching about those administrative requirements should have a flourished knowledge in the management of Nuclear Regulatory Commission and the general knowledge required for the administrative requirements.

Finally, some departments should be set up to supervise the processing of the elimination of the administrative requirements. Those departments should also have a general idea of they are going to do, and they must not have a connection, or profits with Nuclear Regulatory Commision.
