The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) recently published a Federal Register Notice announcing our intent to submit information collection requests to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) for 10 CFR Part 73, Physical Protection of Plants and Materials. 4. How can the burden of the information collection be minimized, including the use of automated collection techniques or other forms of information technology?
