12. Radioactive material shall only be used by, or under the supervision and in the physical presence of, individuals who have successfully completed the training described in the application dated April 29, 2016.
13. The licensee shall not open sealed sources containing radioactive material or remove sources from source holders, except as specifically authorized.
14. The licensee shall conduct a physical inventory every six months to account for all sealed sources received, transferred and possessed under the license. The records of the inventories shall be maintained for inspection by the Agency for three years from the date of the inventory and shall include the radionuclide, number of curies, unique identifying number or serial number, location of each source of radiation, the name of the individual making the inventory, and the date of the inventory.
15. This license does not authorize the distribution of exempt quantities of byproduct or source material.
16. The licensee shall comply with the radioactive material import/export requirements specified in Title 10 Code of Federal Regulations (10 CFR) Part 110.


