This correspondence is sent as requested pursuant to our recent telephone discussion earlier this afternoon to address a few items noted during your review of the most recent *St. Vincent Hospital* licensing action(s). For clarification, please note the following.

1. *No PET studies &/or PET radiopharmaceuticals will be utilized at the St. Vincent Hospital-Kokomo, located at 1907 West Sycamore Street, Kokomo, IN, therefore, no shielding calculations for the remodeling project were required, performed or submitted with this licensing action.*
2. *With regard to the question you had about a 'hot lab' (or lack thereof), please note, there will be a lockable cabinet (to store sealed sources (e.g., Cs-137, Co-57, etc.), a dose calibrator, & GM survey meter, located within the proposed room referred to as "Enclosure B" of the March 20, 2018, letter from my office to yours. The "hot lab" per se, will be incorporated into the imaging room as part of this remodeling effort & re-configuration.*
3. *No PET studies &/or PET radiopharmaceuticals will be utilized at the St. Vincent Hospital (outpatient nuclear cardiology) located at 10590 North Meridian Indianapolis, IN 46290, therefore, no shielding calculations for the remodeling project were required, performed or submitted with this licensing action.*
