SUBJECT: CONTRACT EMPLOYEE, HEART ATTACK FATALITY

A boilermaker at the Surry site, employed by Babcock and Wilcox (B&W) died of a heart attack at 1:00 p.m. on July 14. The boilermaker was a foreman, supervising the repair of an oil fired auxiliary boiler.

Media interest is expected. A press release is not planned by either the NRC or the licensee. The Commonwealth of Virginia has been notified.

This preliminary notification is issued for information only and no further action by IE is anticipated.

The NRC Emergency Response Center received notification of this occurrence by telephone from the licensee at 1:40 p.m. on July 14.
