SURRY POWER STATION UNIT NOS. 1 AND 2
PROPOSED TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION CHANGE

Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.90, the Virginia Electric and Power Company requests an amendment, in the form of changes to the Technical Specifications, to Operating Licenses DPR-32 and DPR-37 for the Surry Power Station, Unit Nos. 1 and 2.

The proposed Technical Specification changes reflect the recent reorganization within the Nuclear Operations Department. In addition, previously submitted Technical Specification changes which address other reorganizations within the Nuclear Operations Department, Quality Assurance Department, and Maintenance and Performance Services Department, are being resubmitted at this time to provide you with a single, comprehensive proposed change. Thus, this proposed change combines our submittals dated March 16, 1982, June 28, 1982, August 3, 1982, August 9, 1982, June 30, 1983, and October 27, 1983, with the most recent reorganization as described in this submittal.

In order to meet the requirements of ANS 3.1-(12/79 Draft) we are planning a "phased" verification of the specific qualification requirements of the standard. The task analysis required by paragraph 5.3.1 of ANS 3.1-(12/79 Draft) will be performed. Individual background and experience will be considered to assure that the intent of the standard is met.

The proposed Technical Specification changes are provided in Attachment 1. A discussion of the proposed Technical Specifications is provided in Attachment 2.

This request has been reviewed and approved by the Station Nuclear Safety and Operating Committee and the Safety Evaluation and Control Staff. It has been determined that this request does not pose an unreviewed safety question as defined in 10 CFR 50.59 and does not pose a significant hazards consideration as defined in 10 CFR 50.92.

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
