Dear Mr. Schwencer:

In accordance with Mr. Goller's letter of July 1, 1975 this letter provides annual updating information regarding our plans for refueling of the R. E. Ginna Nuclear Power Plant.

It is our present intention to shut down for the Cycle 7-8 refueling on or about March 15, 1978. The date is not firmly established yet and is dependent upon availability of replacement power and sufficient reserve capacity both within the Rochester Gas and Electric system and in the New York Power Pool. We are presently anticipating a six week outage and, therefore, would expect to restart on or about May 1, 1978.

Reload fuel and analysis for the Cycle 8 loading will be supplied by Exxon Nuclear Company. Inasmuch as the fuel will be of a different design than our present reload fuel and is being supplied by a different supplier, we would expect to submit analysis supporting Cycle 8 operation to the NRC for approval. It is currently anticipated that this analysis will be submitted in late December 1977.
