10 CFR 50 APPENDIX R MODIFICATION SCHEDULE

The purpose of this letter is to provide information on the status of certain Unit 1 modifications related to 10 CFR 50 Appendix R. On November 30, 1984 (Serial No. 692), we submitted schedules for completion of various Appendix R items for Surry Unit Nos. 1 and 2. This submittal included schedules for modifications to be completed during the Fall 1985 maintenance outage.

On August 4, 1985 Unit 1 was inadvertently tripped. Since we were within the window for the required snubber inspection outage, the Fall 1985 maintenance outage was started. This was approximately eight (8) weeks earlier than previously planned.

The modification described below, numbered in accordance with Volume II, Chapter 6 of the Surry Appendix "R" reanalysis dated November 30, 1984, has been rescheduled as noted.

4KV Pump Motor Control Isolation (Section I, Item #13)

A postulated fire in the Control Room could render the 4KV pumps in the residual heat removal and component cooling water systems inoperable. This modification will provide a transfer switch for each of the affected pumps which will isolate the control circuit from the control room.


Due to the advanced maintenance outage, materials were not available to complete this work. The completion of this design change will take place before the end of the 1986 refueling outage.
