DRUG PANEL AND CUT-OFF LEVEL CHANGES

Pursuant to 10 CFR 26, Appendix A, Subpart A, §1.1 (2), Virginia Electric and Power Company has implemented changes to its Fitness for Duty Program and herein provides the required notification.

Effective July 1, 1995, methaqualone, benzodiazepines, and barbiturates were eliminated from the panel of drug test substances. The revised panel composition complies directly with the requirements of 10 CFR 26, Appendix A, Subpart B, §2.1 (a). In addition, confirmatory test cut-off levels were moderated within the limitations of 10 CFR 26, Appendix A, Subpart B, §2.7 (f)(2) for three substances as follows:
