**RE: PC# 94-3824 SURRY POWER STATION UNDERGROUND OIL RELEASE SITE
CHARACTERIZATION REPORT EXTENSION REQUEST**

Dear Mr. Anderson:

Due to complications with our investigation of the fuel oil release of May 9, 1994, at Surry Power Station, we requested and received a sixty-day extension for submittal of the Initial Abatement Report. The extension also applied to the Site Characterization Report (SCR), which was originally due July 8, 1994.

We have made plans to install monitoring wells as the initial part of the SCR; however, due to nuclear-related activities in the vicinity of the fuel oil lines, we will not be able to begin drilling until approximately August 31, 1994. The station recently completed a maintenance outage on Unit 2 during which they produced radioactive waste material. The station is currently processing the radioactive material and has processing equipment installed in the yard area near the fuel oil lines. The waste processing equipment is blocking access for the drilling rig. Thus, we request another 60 day extension for the submittal of the SCR.
