

RESPONSE TO GENERIC LETTER 90-03

We have received your letters dated March 20, 1990 and May 14, 1990 on the above subject. Generic Letter 90-03 asked that our vendor interface programs be reviewed to assure that the requirements of the Generic Letter are met or the requirements were scheduled for implementation.

Virginia Electric and Power Company has completed a review of its vendor interface programs. We have identified some problems with this program and are in the process of upgrading the administrative procedures which control these interfaces to ensure our programs will comply with the Generic Letter. We do participate in the Nuclear Plant Reliability Data System (NPRDS) and the Significant Event Evaluation and Information Network (SEE-IN). The procedure upgrade is expected to be implemented by September 30, 1991. We will be in conformance with the requirements of Generic Letter 90-03 at that time.
