

WAS LISTENING TO A FRIEND OF YOURS YESTERDAY, THANKSGIVING DAY, ON KFI AM LOS ANGELES ... WOW, THAT RADIO SHOW WAS THE BEST AWAKENING I'VE HAD IN MONTHS. THE ^(CONGRESSMAN) (SENATOR?) HAD SOME GREAT VIEWS ON OUR NATIONAL TROUBLES & CERTAINLY YOU TEND TO LISTEN CAREFULLY TO SOMEONE YOU AGREE WITH; I FOUND MYSELF NODDING MY HEAD IN APPROVAL ... TOO BAD NOT EVERY SENATOR & HOUSE MEMBER COULDN'T HAVE BEEN HERE IN SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA TO LISTEN TO THE COMMENTS & EXCHANGES FROM MR & MRS AVERAGE CITIZEN, THE PEOPLE WHO CALLED IN TO SPEAK WITH HIM LIVE ... HE MENTIONED DURING HIS AIR TIME THAT YOU WOULD BE THE ONE TO WRITE REGARDING A PROBLEM I SHARE WITH ONE OF THE RADIO SHOWS LISTENERS.

HERE IS THE PROBLEM. I WROTE A LETTER IN AUG. 91 TO PRESIDENT BUSH, AGAIN IN SEPT., AGAIN IN OCT. ... ASKED FOR A REPLY AND STILL NOTHING! NO FORM LETTER, NO NOTHING. REMEMBERING WHAT MY DAD ONCE TOLD ME; I WAS 12 & HAD JUST BEEN AWARDED THE EAGLE SCOUT BADGE, 3 DAYS BEFORE MY 13TH BIRTHDAY ... HE SAID "SON, IF YOU'VE GOT A BEEF, SOMETHING THAT BOTHERS YOU, ASK QUESTIONS! AND WHEN YOU DO, GO TO THE TOP! DON'T WASTE YOUR TIME WITH ALL THE MIDDLE MEN ... IF YOU DO, YOUR ANSWER WILL BE SO LATE IN ARRIVING, YOU'LL PROBABLY FORGET THE QUESTION !! HE WAS SO RIGHT. I'M

STILL WAITING FOR AN ANSWER FROM MR. BUSH & NOW, THAT 3 MONTHS HAS ALREADY PASSED I'VE FORGOTTEN MUCH OF WHAT I WROTE.

My concerns included TRANSPORTATION OF NUCLEAR CONTAMINATED EQUIPMENT (OVERSTUFFED TRUCK TRANSPORTING PUMP EQUIPMENT FROM SURREY NUC POWER PLANT UP Mercury Blvd. TO I 64, THE MAIN LINK BETWEEN Williamsburg VA. & NORFOLK VA. DURING MORNING RUSH HOUR WEEK DAY TRAFFIC !! HOW INSANE! My 15 year old SON WAS IN SCHOOL THEN JUST A FEW MILES AWAY. Sure I was concerned... afraid for his safety! L.A. radio reported that a great deal of HAZARDOUS ACTIVE WATER WAS SPILLED ON THE INTERSTATE! CLEAN UP CREWS WORKED HOURS TO CLEAN UP THE MESS!! I CALLED A PUBLIC INFO. OFFICER IN D.C. (WOMAN) SHE COULDN'T GIVE ME ANY ANSWERS! ASKED HER TO CALL OR WRITE BACK HOW COULD SUCH A THING TAKE PLACE, WHO SHOULD I CALL, OR WRITE OR COMPLAIN TO, SHE COULDN'T ANSWER ANY OF MY QUESTIONS!! SHE SAID, LOOK UP THE NUCLEAR REG. COMMISSION # & CALL THEM... I SCREAMED IN ANGER "I JUST TOLD YOU I WAS CALLING FROM CALIFORNIA! NOT DOWN THE STREET, AND HUNG UP! (A) (M) ... WROTE GEORGE A LETTER, MAILED IT... STILL NO ANSWER! ABOUT 5 OR 6 WEEKS LATER I WROTE AGAIN, THIS TIME FROM THE WAITING AREA LOBBY OF THE V.A. HOSPITAL IN LONG BEACH CALIFORNIA...

MY CONCERNS WERE ABOUT HEALTH CARE
NO ANSWER. NEXT LETTER SUPPORTED MY EXPENSES
WITH TRYING TO GET AID FROM V.A. HOSPITAL re:
STATE DISABILITY; WORKMANS COMP; AND STILL
NO ANSWERS.

PLEASE TELL ME: WHO SHOULD I
WRITE TO? WHO WILL WRITE BACK? I AM
A CITIZEN OF THIS UNITED STATES, A VETERAN,
AM NOW 50 YEARS OLD, AM UNEMPLOYED, &
STRUGGLING TO SURVIVE ONE DAY AT A TIME.
