

STATUS OF RESPONSE TO GENERIC LETTER 90-03

Generic Letter 90-03, dated March 20, 1990, required that vendor interface programs be reviewed to assure that the requirements of the generic letter are met. Our response of September 25, 1990 stated that the review of Virginia Electric and Power Company's vendor interface program had been completed and that certain administrative procedures which control these interfaces were scheduled to be upgraded by September 30, 1991.

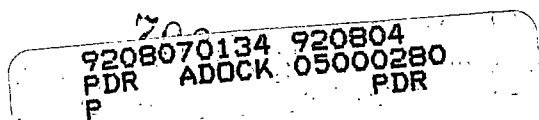
